We are delighted to announce that this year's Art @the Rock will feature a youth exhibit as a part of the Art Show. Art work will remain on display for the duration of Art @ the Rock and be judged by a panel of artists.

Please see below for the "pilot" guidelines. Youth may mail their artwork for the exhibit; art work must arrive by Friday, November 19th to be included in the exhibit. Please mail the art work to Rock Eagle 4-H Center care of Tina Maddox Owen. Youth may also deliver the art work by 12 Noon on Friday, November 19th to the Georgia EMC Senior Pavilion at Rock Eagle 4-H Center. Art @ the Rock will have the art on display Saturday and Sunday, November 20th and 21st. If you have a need to drop off art work to Rock Eagle prior to the November 19th date, please email Mandy B. Marable at mmarable@uga.edu to make arrangements.

The Art @ the Rock committee has prepared recognition opportunities for the youth exhibitors. Recognition will be as follows: Overall People's Choice Awards for all categories in the form of a 1st, 2nd and 3rd place ribbon to include a small cash prize for these placings. Honorable Mention Ribbons will also be given for the Overall Category. Cloverleaf (4th through 6th grade), Junior (7th through 8th grade) and Senior (9th through 12th grade) 4-H'ers will be evaluated in their peer groups and certificates for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded for the peer group categories.

- Art must arrive by mail to Rock Eagle 4-H Center or be delivered to Rock Eagle 4-H Center by Friday, November 19th in order to be included in the exhibition. Georgia 4-H/Art @ the Rock will not be responsible for damage.
- Art can be in any of the following forms: Clay, Fiber/Leather, Glass, Jewelry, Metal, Painting (Oil/Water/Acrylic), Photography, Wood, Mixed Media, or Drawing/Graphics/Printmaking. You may submit art for each of the forms mentioned.
- Art will be exhibited in the following peer groups: Cloverleaf, Junior and Senior.
- Art work can be picked up after 4 p. m. on Sunday; November 21st. Art work can also be picked up at Fall Forum or be returned by the District Project Achievement in 2011. Please specify on your submission form how you will retrieve your Art Work. **Art work will not be mailed back to the exhibitor.**
